7. Any other Business

• Topic #1:. Dylan Owen suggested that the summer cup rules where 5 players are required and 2 can play twice were adopted for the winter league. For merit purposes only the first game counts. Reg Williams suggested 6 players required John Fenlon suggested the captain was the only player who could play twice. Grant Carrington suggested that it could only be done twice a season in the form of a "joker". Richard Johnson suggested that the opposition captain chose the player.

Voted and carried – the rule change will be:

- 1. 6 Players Required (7 frames) one can play twice if the team is short
- 2. If a player is to be played twice then the opposition captain will choose that player from the 6 who have played
- 3. Merit will be awarded on first frame only
- Topic #2: Reg Williams raised the question of cup matches being played at the end of the season. John Fenlon produced a mock-up of how the league will look.
 John Fenlon pointed out that those teams knocked out of all the cups would have an 8 week break without a match at the end of the league up to presentation night.
 Steve Banner said he could potentially loose players if not in any cups
 Voted and decided to leave it as it is.
