Summer Cup Format

Format.

- Each match will have 5 games of singles and 2 games of (standard) doubles.
- Up to 4 players from each team can play twice, chosen by your own captain, players are permitted to play one singles and one doubles or two doubles, but doubles are NOT to be played with the same partner. A minimum of 5 players is therefore required to constitute a team.
- The 7 games can be played in any order.
- Normal 'winter league' (black ball) rules will apply.
- Home team will nominate on all games, players will then lag for break.
- Referees will be alternate, the home team supplying the first one.
- Match cards can be downloaded via the "download" tab on the website
- Teams dropping out will have all matches removed
- There will be no merit.

Winners

Each team will play all other teams home and away. At the end of the league phase the top two teams will play off to decide the cup winner.

In the event of a draw in the league phase the winner will be decided in the following order:

- 1. The results of the tied teams against each other, eg, team A beat team B 5-2 at home but lost 4-3 away, team A will proceed (by 2 pt)
- 2. Matches won.
- 3. Teams total points scored away from home.
- 4. Play off

A perpetual cup will be awarded to the winning team on the night of the final (to be returned next year)

Eligible players

There will be no 'sign-on' for the summer cup. Anyone can play as long as they only play for one team – no transfers are allowed.

Submission of results

The match result will be submitted by WhatsApp to John Fenlon by winning team captain. Please use the summer cup WhatsApp group

The competition will not require a registration fee, a cup will be donated by the winter league.

Registration.

Because only 5 players are required per team some venues may wish to enter two teams. A maximum of two teams per home table will be permitted.
